Wild program sales- Associations were selected at the last president's meeting. Coon Rapids was selected for Oct. 5<sup>th</sup>, Centennial and North Branch were selected for future dates and Andover, St. Cloud and Elk River were selected for back-up.

Helmet Rule for Coaches- Helmets must be worn by all coaches and players after September 1<sup>st</sup> during any association sponsored event. This is a USA, MN Hockey rule. Tim has already received a complaint from someone about an association. First offense is a letter from Tim; second offense is a 30 day suspension and a \$100 fine.

Player Registration - Any learn to skate program run by the association will need to have players registered with USA Hockey and MN Hockey. Many associations run their learn to skate programs through the arena or the figure skating program to avoiding registering with USA and MN Hockey.
